Emphasis: If we are going to continue moving forward to claim the abundant life God has prepared for EGBC, we must be diligent to avoid setbacks.

19 ... all silver and gold, and every vessel of bronze and iron, are holy to the LORD; they shall go into the treasury of the LORD.

1. We avoid setbacks by keeping our hearts fixed on the LORD
